Interventional Pain Medicine procedures performed:

Injections for chronic pain and chronic joint pain: X-ray and ultrasound guided

- Genicular nerve block for chronic knee pain (for patients not suitable for joint replacement surgery or post joint replacement surgery pain)
- Ultrasound guided shoulder, elbow, wrist, knee, hip and ankle injection
- Ultrasound guided trochanter bursa injection
- Epidural injections – lumbar, caudal, transforaminal, Nerve Root Blocks
- Sacroiliac joint injections
- Facet joint Diagnostic Medial Branch Block
- Diagnostic/therapeutic facet joint/medial branch blocks
- Radiofrequency denervation procedures
- Pulsed radiofrequency treatment to nerve roots, trunks and peripheral nerves
- Coccyx injection
- Greater Occipital Nerve Block
